A message from Mrs. Denham

We want to say a huge thank you to our amazing PTA who have just given the school a cheque for £10,000! WOW WOW. We are so grateful to them all for their support, dedication and passion to raise money for your children. Thank you to you as parents and your families for supporting all their events and ideas. This amount of money makes a significant difference to the education of your children. We are looking into buying the following with the amount raised:

£670 to pay for iPad; £3,500 for an adventure trail in the Holywell Hollow; £2000 divided into £500 per class to be spent on much needed resources; £1500 on reading books; £200 for outdoor playtime toys; £100 for a gazebo and the rest on new Amazon Fires.

Preschool

We are encouraging parents who want to take up a 30 hour place in the Summer Term to apply now – and no later than the end of February to get their code in good time. HMRC sometimes needs more information from the parent to check whether they're eligible, so parents should allow time for this.

If you already have an eligibility code, you will need to reconfirm your eligibility for 30 hours and / or Tax-Free Childcare every 3 months.

Please note: the summer term runs from 1st April to 31st August. Any parents who do not take up a summer place will need to wait until September to take up 30 hours. You will find all the childcare options, including Tax-Free Childcare, via the Childcare Choices website.

We still have places available in Pre-school on all days. Pre-school is a valued part of our school community and is an important link to the success of the school which we are very keen to keep as a thriving asset to the school. 
