Can we please also remind all parents that if you wish to take your child out of school during term time you must complete a form called "52 Absence request Form 'Exceptional Circumstances' " which can be downloaded from the website or obtained from the school office. However, please will you make an appointment to see me (Mrs Denham) before you complete the form to explain why you need to take your child out of school. This MUST be asked for as soon as you are considering removing your child from school NOT after the event has been booked. This is a Government law and does NOT grant parents an automatic right to take their child out of school during term time - these have to be "exceptional circumstances". They have stated that schools can issue penalty notices and fines and that pupils are only in school for 190 days out of a year of 365 days - they have at least 13 weeks holiday a year away from school. Staff and governors are not being difficult over this matter - this is a law and we are trying very hard to work with it and also at the same time be supportive to parents and families. Thank you for your understanding with both of these matters.

Please can we also remind parents they MUST sign their children out or back into school if they have been taken to an appointment etc. the form is kept in the school office.

All through the Autumn term, pupils in their school house groups have been earning points for good behaviour, effort and following the school Christian values. At the start of half term or the first Monday back after a longer holiday we have decided the winning team will be allowed to wear non uniform. Therefore, on Monday 11th January 'St George's' the Red house group will have a non-school uniform day in celebration of them coming top in the house group point league. Well done to St George's.
