A message from Mrs. Denham

For their Wow day on Thursday the children enjoyed a visit from Mrs. Recycle and 'Plastic Free North Devon.' The children were able to access VR headsets allowing them to 'dive' into the Great Barrier reef, where they saw much marine life. The children were quick to understand the link between these beautiful creatures and the importance of protecting them and the ocean from plastic waste.

Some quotes from Squirrels class:

'Animals think that some plastic or rubbish in the ocean is their food.'

'I didn't realise that when you burnt plastic it turns into really bad fumes.'

'I learnt that even when you recycle, some of it doesn't get made into something, some of it gets burnt. So you should not buy as much plastic.'

Children enjoyed collecting shells and drift wood from Mrs. Recycles 'shore line.' However, many were surprised by what was left at the end of the collecting...far too much plastic waste! It was lovely to see so many children keen to share their knowledge on environmental issues and take away some fantastic ideas to reduce, reuse, recycle.
