## A message from Mrs. Denham

Dear parents and carers

We are thrilled that we now have better I.T. equipment in school, each class has six new devices and the children are enjoying using them. We are so very grateful to our PTA and the local community for their support and help to obtain them.

### ARRIVAL TIME FOR KS1 & KS2:

**KS2 children (Foxes and Squirrels)** to arrive from 8.30am but they **MUST** be in school by 8.45am.

**KS1 children (Hedgehogs and Robins)** to arrive from 8.40am but they **MUST** be in school by 8.50am

Sadly, parents still won't be allowed on the playground. Instead children will go straight into their classrooms as soon as they arrive through the gate. A member of staff will be on the gate at 8.30am and will sanitise the children's hands as normal.

If a parent has siblings in both KS1 and KS2, they can arrive by 8.40am and children will be in school by the needed time.

Please ensure all children are in school by 8:50am.

### Driving Through the Villages of Taw stock & Eastacombe:

Please can I remind everyone driving to school through the lanes and villages of Tawstock & Eastacombe to reduce your speed accordingly. We have received several complaints from the local community regarding the inconsiderate speed at which some cars are travelling. We also have several families who live in these villages who walk their children to and from school. All routes to the school have narrow lanes and we have heard of a few near misses involving families from our school. We all leave and arrive at different time, so please respect other road users and keep your speed down; I am sure you will all agree that their safety is paramount.
