A message from Mrs. Denham

It has been lovely to be back into school and see all the children's smiley faces and hear all about their Christmas holiday adventures. What a change in temperature we have seen this week! Can we please ask that you send your child into school with a warm coat and hat and gloves as you feel is necessary. We are obviously ventilating the classroom as much as possible but we trying to ensure the classrooms stay as warm as possible. We open all the doors at playtimes and lunchtimes to allow a clear flow of air throughout the classroom.

A main priority in school is to promote a LOVE OF READING in every child. Over the last year we have heavily invested in new ways of supporting your child to read. We have purchased the Read Write Inc phonics programme to develop a structures and systematic approach to learning phonics, writing and writing throughout the school, but especially in KS1. It is designed to create fluent readers, confident speakers and willing writers. This programme is a method of teaching reading, which is centred around learning the sounds of the letters (phonics) and then blending them together. Following this, children then have the opportunity to learn to break down the words into individual sounds in order to write them. We have also bought the Accelerated Reader programme which is a computer-based program that we use to monitor reading practice and progress. It helps us guide children to books that are at children's individual reading levels. The children take short quizzes after reading a book to check if they've understood it. We hope your children will be able to tell you about these programmes in the coming weeks.
