This Sunday (19th March) all are invited to a special mothering Sunday family service in St Peter's Church at 11.00am. We'll be celebrating mothering and praying for all mothers.

Check if your child can get free school meals and additional funding support

All children in reception, year 1 and year 2 at state schools in England automatically get free school meals. However, parents and guardians are encouraged to apply for free school meals when they enrol their child in school, as this can help their child's school to attract additional 'pupil premium' funding to support learning.

From year 3 onwards, children whose parents are getting any of the following are entitled to free school meals:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods).
- Income Support (IS).
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA).
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA).
- The quaranteed element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income that does not exceed £16,190).
- Working Tax Credit run-on (the payment you get for a further 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit).

How to apply

Apply through the <u>Devon Citizens Portal</u>. This is the quickest and easiest way to apply and will result in you getting an instant decision. Alternatively, call the Education Helpline on 0345 155 1019.

IMPORTANT - Paignton Zoo Trip - Robin & Hedgehog Classes

Although the Paignton Zoo trip is free due to the amazing work from the PTA to secure funding for the coach, and Paignton Zoo offering free entry during March we still require you to consent for your child to attend through ParentPay.

<u>Driving Through the Villages of Tawstock & Eastacombe:</u>

Please can we remind everyone driving to school through the lanes and villages of Tawstock & Eastacombe to reduce your speed accordingly. We have received several complaints from the local community regarding the inconsiderate speed at which some cars are travelling. We also have several families who live in these villages who walk their children to and from school. All routes to the school have narrow lanes and we have heard of a few near misses involving families from our school. We all leave and arrive at different time, so please respect other road users including pedestrians and keep your speed down; I am sure you will all agree that our children's safety is paramount.

School News

Changes to Early Years Funding

We have attached a chart to this newsletter to show the changes the government have announced which include the dates on which they take effect.

30 hour codes for the Summer Term

In order to access 30hour funding for the Summer Term 2023 (which for funding purposes starts on 1st April 2023) parents need to have applied to HMRC through their Government Gateway Account and received a cade by 31st March 2023. Any codes with an eligible date of 1st April onwards will not be funded in Summer 2023 term. We encourage parents to apply in plenty of time incase HMRC require any additional information.

Sadly, a number of families across Devon did not reconfirm their details and missed the 31st of December deadline for Spring Term, moved settings in the Grace Period or had a gap in eligibility meaning they could not claim 30 hours funding in the Spring. Please make sure this doesn't happen to you.
