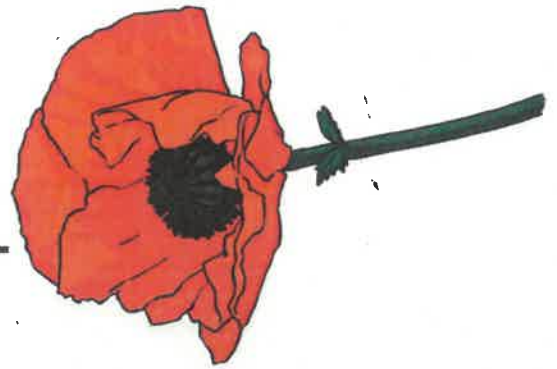
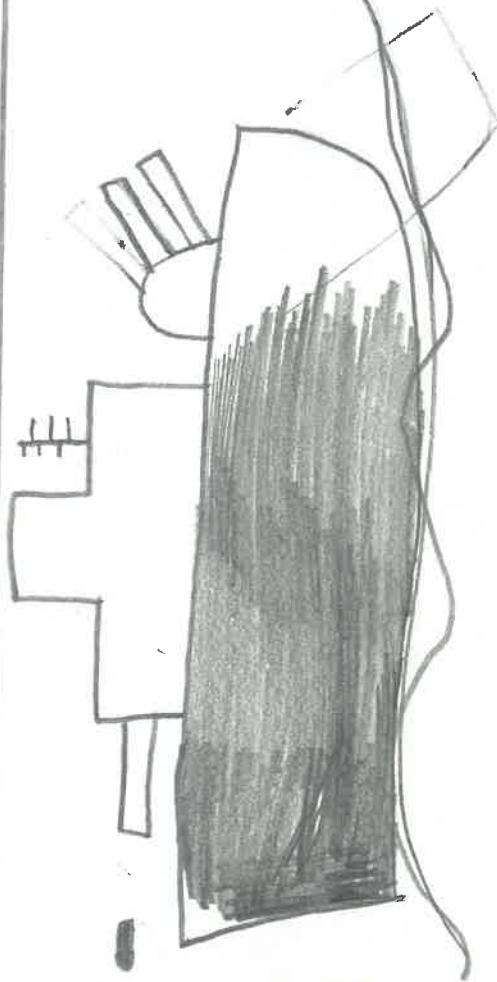
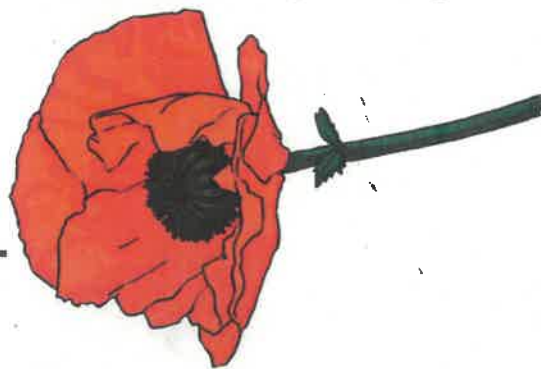


Why do you droop, snowdrops?

screaming - screaming.

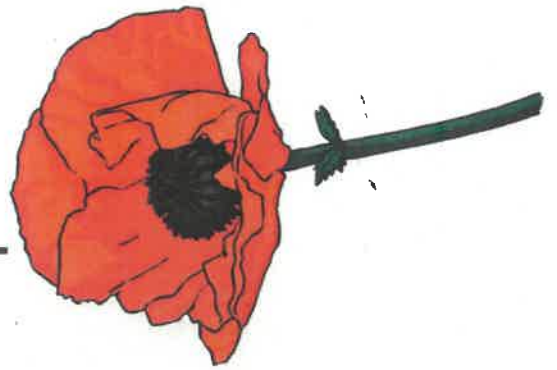


We remember the rolls of the ship exploding and

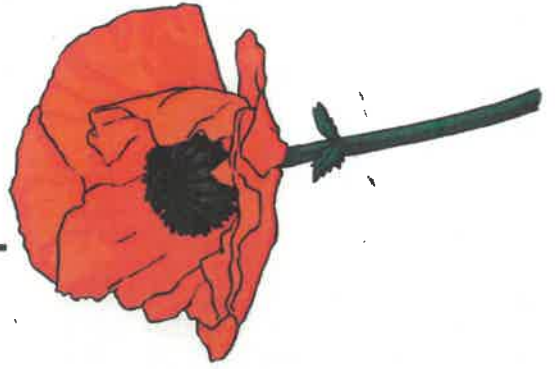

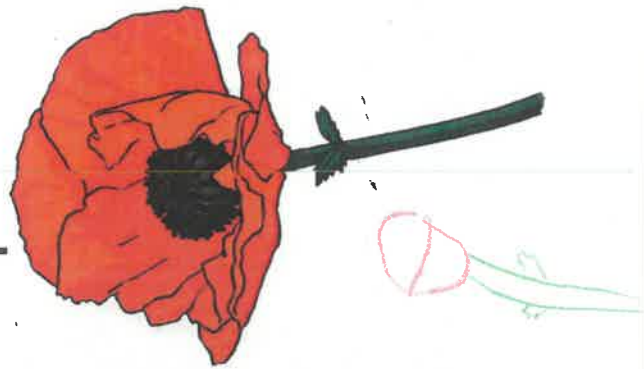


Why so down, red rose?

remembers remembers remembers!

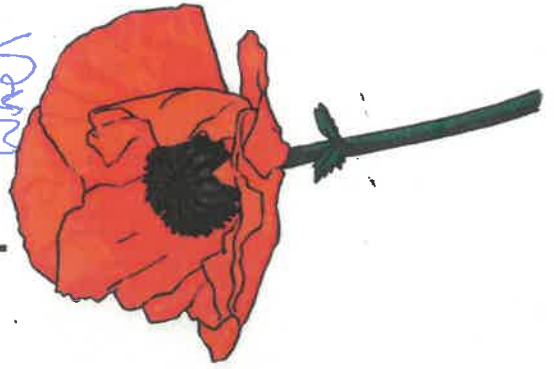

We need to ~~remember~~ ^{remember} the people that gave their lives for us in the 2nd and 1st World Wars wars.

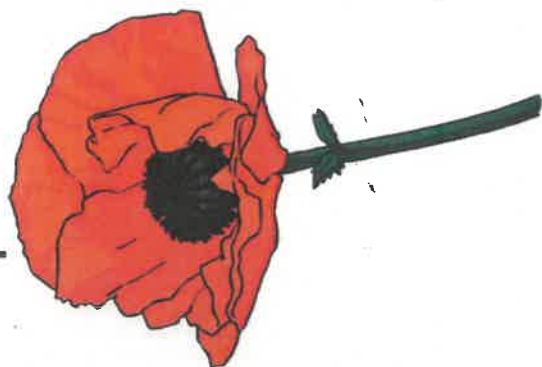
