School Menu

Please find attached to this newsletter the menu which will take effect from 1st November. All children in Reception to Year 2 inclusive are eligible for a free school meal under the Universal Income Free School Meal Scheme. (UIFSM) The cost of a school meal for those children in Year 3 to 6 remains at £2.30, please pay in advance on Parent Pay. Everyone should have already received an email from the school regarding this.

Late applications may be disadvantaged, so it is essential to make an on time application to give the best chance of securing a place at one of your preferred schools.
