- Parents to book via email to the office and to pay via ParentPay and children collected from school gate each morning
- Children to be offered a selection of breakfasts and drinks from menu
- Children to be taken to classroom at start of school day
- Cost £4.00 per session

After school Club

- Staff to collect children from school gate at the end of the day and go into the Phoenix Room for drink and a sandwich type of snack
- Maximum of 8 children at any time
- Parents to book via email to office and to pay via ParentPay. Children to be taken down to the school gate for collection.
- Children to be offered a selection of snacks and drinks from menu
- Child can attend clubs run after school by teachers and then attend ASC afterwards
- Cost £4.00 3.15 to 4.15pm and £8.00 from 3.15 to 5.15pm

We hope parents will take us up this fabulous offer as we have organised it as a request directly from many parents.
