#### Road & Lane

#### Holywell pre-school

• In line with the new guidance, from Monday 11 January 2021 our preschool will continue to be open to all children, as they normally would be. Therefore, if you haven't sent your child back into pre-school as you are not a critical worker, please do so if you would like them to attend. Please book in your normal way through Mrs Palmer in the office.

#### **Vodafone Sim Card**

Vodafone UK wanted to do their part to help keep children and parents connected and be able to continue learning from home during this difficult time. They have given away for free 250,000 data SIMs with 30GB of data to use for 90 days.

We requested and have been allocated a small number of Vodafone data SIM cards to give out to parents who have problems logging on to the Wi-Fi for their children to access Microsoft Teams from home. As they are limited, they will be given out on a first come first served basis.

- ❖ Vodafone data SIM to use as a Wi-Fi replacement.
- ❖ 30GB data (lasts for 90 days)
- Need a smart laptop/dongle that has a slot for a sim card or a smart phone that takes a sim card
- Need good Vodafone signal (you can use the Network Status tracker on www.vodafone.co.uk)
- If your phone is locked to another network, you just need to contact your network provider's customer service team to request for your phone to be unlocked.
- You won't be able to use your phone to make calls/texts while using this data SIM.
- ❖ You will be able to enjoy 30GB data for 90 days this will start once you insert the SIM into your phone and start using the data.
