Dear Parents

Administering of prescription medication:

Please can I remind parents that the school is allowed to administer 'prescription' only medicine, but this can only be done if you have signed the relevant paperwork which is kept in the school office. We also require the medicine to be drawn up in a syringe. Advice from the School Nurse; if the medicine says three times a day this means at regular intervals throughout the day, every 8 hours. In this instance the medicine should not be required to be administered in school. At no time should children bring medicine into school to self-administer. We have children who are allergic to certain medicines so we have to be vigilant that we know exactly what medicines are on site.

If you have booked a Christmas Meal on Thursday 7th December, please arrive at school by 11.30 am. The lunch is being served at 11.45 am.

Christingle Service

On Thursday December 17 we have our Christmas Carol Service and Christingle at St Peter's Church starting at 2pm. We aim to walk to the Church between 1.30 and 1.50pm. However, as the road gets very busy with so many cars going to the Service, it ends up taking us a very long time to get all the children down to the Church. We have to stop so many times to let cars past. Therefore, can we please ask that parents either:

- Park at school and walk with us to the Church. Once the Service is over, then walk their own child back down to school to pick up their car from school
- Drive their car down to the Church either before 1.30pm or after 1.50pm so we don't have to stop to let cars pass by.
