# A message from Mrs. Denham

We would like to say a big thank you to Ms Winfield and Ms Dart for the lovely Christmas lunch they laid on for the children as well as the excellent Christmas baps for the staff. It was a lovely atmosphere with the year 5 & 6 children singing along to the Christmas music as they patiently waited to be served. The children would also like to thank the PTA for the kind gift for them to wear which made the occasion even more Christmassy.

Next week we are holding the two Nativity performances in the hall and would ask that all parents/grandparents etc. who are attending if they could please take a Lateral Flow Test before they arrive and also wear a face mask whilst in the hall.

The Christingle and Carol service is due to take place on Thursday at St Peters church but we are still in talks with the Rev. Gary and St Peters regarding this. We will let you know the outcome as soon as we have it. However, if it does go ahead we ask again that you take a Lateral Flow Test before you arrive and again wear face-masks at all times in the church.

If this doesn't go ahead, we will hold a Christingle service for the children in school in the same way as we did last year.

#### **Swop Shop**

Our annual pupil SWOP SHOP will go ahead on the morning of Monday December 13th 2021.

We would be very grateful, if you are able to send in a donation of presents suitable for a mum, dad, and brothers and sisters, such as small bubble bath, talc, soap, pens, pencils, chocolates, sweets, gloves, socks etc. This 'Swap Shop' will hopefully be a way for you to be able to 'recycle' some of the small presents you do not need, that you have at home! Any donations of wrapping paper and tags/labels will also be useful. On the day the children are able to choose and wrap at least a couple of presents to bring home for Christmas Day. There will be no charge so you do not have to send in money!

### **Important information regarding Breakfast and After School Clubs**

The After School Club will continue as now until the end of this academic year as well as the Breakfast Club on Mondays, Tuesdays. and Wednesdays when they will both be reviewed. However, the Breakfast Club on Thursdays and Fridays will have to be booked in advance as staff will only be employed on a casual basis. The reason for the amendment to Thursday and Friday Breakfast Club is that we have no regular bookings.

The children have really enjoyed wearing their jumpers over the last 3 weeks and the final day will be the last day of term 17<sup>th</sup> December.
