EDUKIDS

We are thrilled to be able to tell you that both Holywell and Bratton have join up with Edukids a wonderful charity based in Bideford.

Edukid work with children living in extreme poverty in Uganda. They support students through their education, from primary school all the way up to university and vocational training. Edukid believes that all children have the right to attend school, and that it is a long-term solution to enabling communities to break out of the poverty cycle.

Before the Harvest Festival Service Edukids will be introducing themselves to the children in an assembly at school and then the representative will be joining us at the church service.

Harvest Festival

Next **Wednesday 20th October** is our annual **Harvest Festival** at Tawstock Parish Church and it would be lovely if you were able to join the children in this celebration. This year the service is taking place in the afternoon. Please arrive at the church between 2:20pm and 2:30pm which will allow for the children to arrive at the church without too many stops for passing cars.

The service is due to finish at 3:15pm. If you are not attending can you, please collect from the church at 3:15pm instead of the school.

If you need ASC that night, we will ensure that children are brought back to school.

As in other years we will be collecting items for the Freedom Centre in Barnstaple. The centre will be grateful of any of the following:

Tins: chopped tomatoes, baked beans, meat and fish

Tinned meals: beef casserole, chicken curry, pot noodles and pasta pots

(with ring pulls if possible as some people may not have access to a tin opener)

Dried herbs and spices, pepper

Fruit

Couscous (not rice or pasta)

Sugar, custard and rice pudding

Coffee, cocoa, instant hot chocolate drink, fruit squash (not tea)

Baking ingredients: dried fruit, baking powder, vanilla essence, chocolate

Sauces: brown sauce, tomato sauce and mayonnaise

Non-bio washing powder, washing up liquid, kitchen rolls

Toilet rolls, shower gel, shampoo and hand wash (not bars of soap)

Cereal bars, granola bars and chocolate biscuit bars

These include Dried herbs and spices, coffee, cocoa, instant hot chocolate drink etc. A full list can be seen on the email attachment.

Please can your child's contribution be brought into school on the morning of Wednesday 20th October 2021 Help would be appreciated.

After the service would any parent be able to take the food items and drop them off to the Freedom Centre, 1 Howard Way, Barnstaple the following day? The Freedom Centre is open Monday to Thursday 9am to 3pm and 9am to 1pm on Friday. Could you please contact the school office before the Harvest Festival on Wednesday if you are able to help? Thank you.
