We have had such a fantastic first week back at school. We were really impressed on Monday at how smart the children looked, their keenness to get into school and see their friends and their enthusiasm for their new classes and teachers. Each class is beginning to learn new routines and build new relationships and think about the year ahead – the classrooms have been a real hive of activity. Despite the end of week tiredness felt by us all the children have shown great resilience and determination and their attitudes to learning have been brilliant. It has been lovely to once again sit in the office and hear the laughter bouncing around the playground, we have no doubt this year is going to be another wonderful year for the whole Holywell family.

Thank you for continuing to drop your child off at the gate in the mornings and pass messages through the staff on duty.
