
Your children have been amazing and have settled into school life remarkably well – in fact most children have been saying how they're loving being back and missed school during lockdown.

We are expecting children to get colds and potentially Flu now that we are back in school. These are to be expected and we are aware that in the current climate these illnesses may cause additional anxiety.




The usual rules apply in terms of sickness and diarrhoea with children having to remain at home for 48 hours clear of any D&V.

If a child arrives at school with a bit of a cold and/or cough, we will keep a close eye on them, especially as we need to keep the children, staff and the rest of our community safe too. It may be the case that we need to send the young person home, in which case we will contact you.

We are of course following very strict hygiene practises within school but as predicted when many children and adults are brought together after months being apart then some illness will happen. This is happening nationally across all schools.

Safely arriving and leaving school

We have been informed by some very concerned and anxious parents that some parents congregate on or around the school site before and after school. It is essential that all children arrive and leave at their designated start or finish time. All adults must always maintain social distancing to reduce the chance of the transmitting the virus. Please leave a clear and wide pathway for children to safely through to get to their class. Please do not block any of the area near the gate.

Please can we remind that the children in Robins and Hedgehogs start school at 9.00am and Foxes and Squirrels at 8.45am. Please can children in Robins and Hedgehogs wait until 9.00am to enter unless they have a sibling in Squirrels or Foxes. We are trying to desperately avoid all the school being in the car park and at the gate at one time. Please do not arrive too early or too late if possible.

Free Nasal Childhood Flu Vaccination

Your child is due to be in Reception to Year 6 from September 2020 and they are therefore eligible for a Free Nasal Childhood Flu Vaccination.

It is anticipated that this will be delivered in schools between October 2020 to December 2020, this will be administered adhering to all up to date Infection Control, PPE and social distancing guidance at the time.

Flu vaccination is one of most effective interventions we have to reduce pressure on the health and social care system which is going to be more important than ever this year. For this reason, it is essential we deliver the vaccine to as many children as possible to prevent the spread of infection to those most at risk in society.
