After-School and Breakfast Clubs

We are able to run both Breakfast and ASC Clubs for 8 children only every day this term, but places must be booked in advance by phone or email. If we are over this number, we require an extra member of staff which we may not be able to provide at short notice. WE ARE NO LONGER PROVIDING ASC ON THE LAST DAY OF EVERY TERM – 31st March and the 21st July 2023. The clubs are now being run by Ms. Scott, Mrs. Lowin and Mrs. Mullen

The cost for Breakfast club is £4.50 per child - can drop off from 8am. After School Club starts - pick-up 4.15pm (£4.50) or 5.15pm (£9.00).

Our Mental Health Support Team are able to offer a new digital therapeutic intervention "Lumi-Nova - Tales of Courage", available free until January 31st 2023.

This is an app aimed at Children aged between 7-12 years old and uses a Low Intensity -Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (LICBT) graded exposure model to help children overcome their worries.
