Breakfast & After-school club (Spaces available).

We are thrilled that both clubs have now been running since our return on the 8th September 2021 and are being well used. It is lovely to see that parents are using this service as we set it up after parents requested this crucial support.

We now have permanent places booked every day after school and a couple in Breakfast Club. We can take up to 8 children per session and the cost for Breakfast club is £4.50 per child which includes breakfast and you can drop off 8am. After-school club starts straight after school with pick-up times of 4.15pm (£4.50) or 5.15pm (£9.00). All children will receive a snack. If you are going to be late or if you need to collect at an alternative time, please can you phone to school by the end of the school day (3.15pm).
